## **BYLAW NO. 2016-01**

BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF BUSINESS LICENSING BYLAW NO. 2014-09 AND BUSINESS LICENSING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2015-25

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, authorizes council to pass bylaws for businesses, business activities and persons engaged in business; and

**WHEREAS** Council of Parkland County has passed Bylaw No. 2014-09 and Bylaw No. 2015-25 pursuant to Section 8(c) of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, with respect to providing a system of licenses, permits or approvals for businesses that operate within Parkland County; and

**WHEREAS** Section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, requires an amendment to a bylaw to be made in the same way as the original bylaw and is subject to the same consents that apply to the passing of the original bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of Parkland County wishes to pass a bylaw for the purpose of repealing Business Licensing Bylaw No. 2014-09 and Business Licensing Amendment Bylaw No. 2015-25;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of Parkland County, duly assembled and under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, hereby enacts the following:

- 1. Bylaw No. 2014-09 and Bylaw No. 2015-25 are hereby repealed.
- 2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of third reading and signing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016.

READ A SECOND TIME this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016.

READ A THIRD TIME and finally passed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016.
