WHEREAS; surrounding Indigenous Nations continue to experience the loss of loved ones and we stand in solidarity with the families here in Parkland County and across Canada who have missing, or murdered family members and Parkland County is committed to actively engage with Indigenous Nations and Peoples in the spirit of reconciliation;

THEREFORE, Parkland County Council does hereby proclaim May 5th as Missing and Murdered Indigenous People Day in Parkland County.
