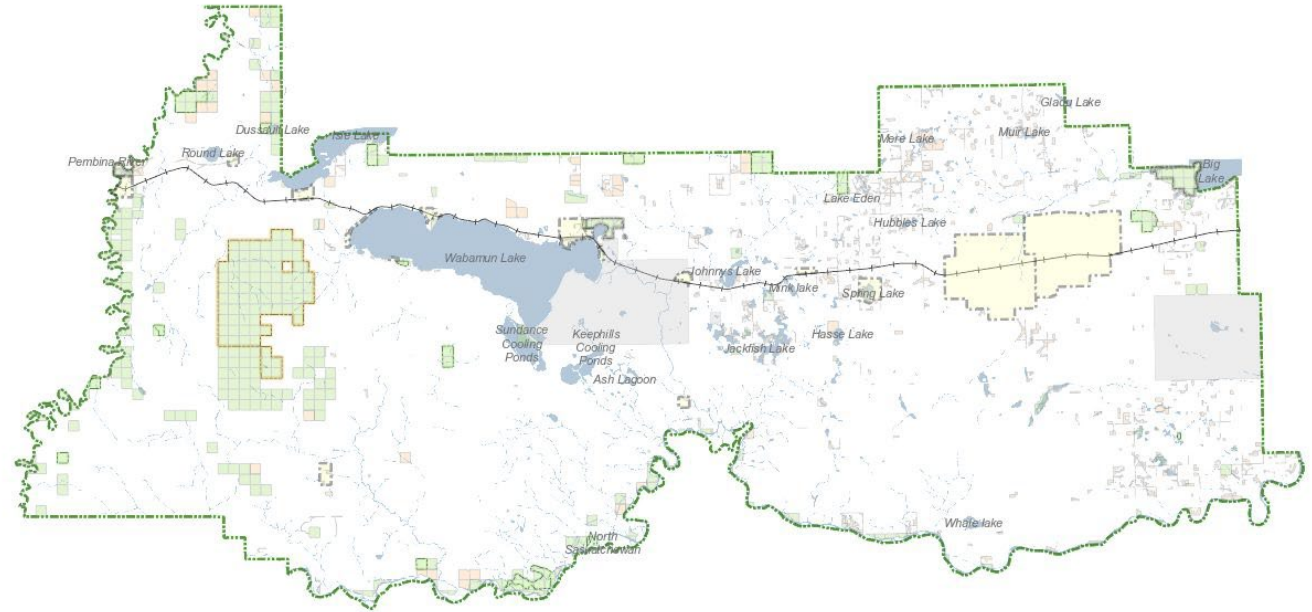


Q3 2025 Update

Road Maintenance and Drainage

Governance and Priorities Committee

November 4, 2025



Operations

Preservation and maintenance of Parkland County roads and drainage infrastructure and the production of aggregate products



Infrastructure

- 1,250 kms of gravel roads
- 892 kms of paved surfaces
- 4,500 kms of ditching and licensed drainage course
- Bridges, storm ponds, lift stations and underground stormwater infrastructure
- Aggregate exploration, extraction and reclamation

Road Maintenance

01

Summer Maintenance

- Dust control completed for 1250 locations (1.9 million litres)
- 92 kms of street sweeping
- 7,500 tonnes of ASBC for surface repair
- 150 km of line painting
- Increased brush control and illegal dumping activities



02

Winter Maintenance

- 10 graders and 9 trucks in service
- Training completed for grader and snowplow operators
- Brushing and right of way maintenance activities





Drainage

01

Summer

- 5 centreline culvert replacements
- 30 Bridge surfaces cleared, replaced or reinforced with matting
- 150 pest control actions including 12 dam removals
- Wabamun catch basin replacement and outfall improvements

Winter

- Brushing and licensed drainage maintenance
- Bridge deck maintenance
- Pest control and culvert maintenance activities



Aggregate

01

Summer

- Mixed 38,000 tonnes of ASBC for Road Maintenance and Engineering
- Engineering design for Wagner Pit reclamation



02

Winter

- Commissioning activities for Burtonsville Pit
- Crushing 100,000 tonnes of aggregate for 2026 programs
- Reclamation activities
