

**Drayton Valley RCMP Detachment**

**Parkland County Statistics**

**April 1, 2020 to November 15, 2020**

The Drayton Valley RCMP Detachment covers a very small portion of Parkland County located to the Northeast of the Town of Drayton Valley

In the period between April 1 and November 15, 2020, the Drayton Valley Detachment attended to approximately 80 calls for service, not including traffic violation charges.

The various types of calls received include the following:

Mental Health – 14 calls were received, 10 of which involved one individual

2 individuals were transported by RCMP to a Mental Health facility in Ponoka.

Mischief to Property – 4 calls were received. One of which was related to a person suffering from Mental Health issues.

1 call involved an individual who drove in a field causing damage to the crop.

Charges were laid. Matter is still before the courts.

2 other calls were unfounded.

Break and Enter – 3 calls were received. One was a garage, which was successful

1 attempted to a shop

1 to transfer station, involved damage to the gate and entry to the employee trailer.

Abandoned Vehicles – 5 reported

1 was a recovered vehicle which had been stolen out of the Breton area

1 was a recovered Dirt bike which had been stolen out of the Morinville area

1 was a recovered vehicle which had been stolen out of Edmonton

1 was a vehicle which had broken down

1 vehicle not located had left prior to members arrival.

Suspicious persons/Vehicles – 4 reported

1 vehicle towed, members had located elderly individual who was

Suffering from a mental episode in which they did not know where they

Were. Members took male to Hospital.

Arson – 3 reported

1 vehicle which had not been reported stolen

2 – same residence, one was a rekindle

Animal Calls – Majority deal with a request to Euthanize injured animals following a motor vehicle collision.

1 involved cows in the complainants field.

Other traffic Offences – 7 reports

2 – involved gravel trucks swerving on the road and passing while unsafe

1 – Dangerous trailer. Member located trailer which had lost a tire.

1 - loud vehicle, not located, no description provided.

1 – report of vehicle's stunting. Vehicles were located and towed, violation  
Violation tickets issued.

1 – report of driver texting and speeding, no licence plate or description given.

1 – erratic driver straddling the center line.

Careless Use of Firearms – 2 reports of gunshots heard. Both deemed to be unfounded and related to  
Fireworks.

Fraud – 2 reports – One involved a vehicle which was bought and the new owner became aware that  
The odometer had been turned back

1 – Identity theft which was unfounded.

Shoplifting – 1 report involving 2 bottles of rum being stolen from store.

Assault – Domestic related – one report – Charges laid.

Fail to Comply and Breach of conditions – 1 involved an individual who had been released on a court  
ordered ankle bracelet. Individual removed bracelet. Warrant for arrest was obtained. Individual was  
later arrested.
