About our community

- Emergence of the Lac Ste. Anne Métis (“LSAM”) community
- Incorporation of Lac Ste. Anne Métis Community Association (“LSAMCA”) to represent the Métis Aboriginal rights and interests of the historic and contemporary LSAM community
- LSAMCA has met the requirements of the Government of Alberta’s *Métis Credible Assertion Process and Criteria* (2020).



New Housing for Seniors (Lac Ste. Anne County)

- 12 homes for Lac Ste. Anne Métis seniors: 8 bungalow, 4 semi-detached
- Occupancy: 2026



Multi-Family Housing (Stony Plain)

- 52 homes for Lac Ste. Anne Métis members: 1 to 4 bedroom
- Occupancy: 2028



Multi-Family Housing (Stony Plain)

- Surplus federal property: former RCMP detachment site (vacated in 2019)
- Designated for affordable housing under the Federal Lands Initiative (FLI), a program led by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC)
- LSAMCA purchased the land in 2022 – commitment is to build 52 energy efficient, affordable, 1-4 bedroom stacked townhouses, with a minimum of 21% of units accessible
- Will include an amenity space for resident gatherings and an early learning and childcare space
- December 2023 – Building demolished
- Summer 2026– Development permit (*submitted for approval*)
- Summer/Fall 2026 – Building permits (*in process*)
- Spring 2027 – Anticipated construction start date
- Fall 2028 – Anticipated completion date
