  - Develop an Action Plan by June 30, 2019
- Composition
  - Three Councillors
  - CAO
  - Staff as appropriate

# SUB-COMMITTEE WORK & RECOMMENDATIONS

- Sub-Committee met 6 times over the course of the project
- Research and engagement with other municipalities
- Council presentations
  - December 2019 – tabled
  - May 2020 – accepted for information
  - July 2020 – accepted for information

## ONGOING WORK

- Indigenous Awareness training rolled out across the entire organization with strong uptake
- Memorandum of Understanding signed with Enoch Cree Nation
- Engagement with the Treaty Relationship Renewal Network
- Recognized September 30, 2021 as the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

## NEXT STEPS

1. Explore further learning and engagement opportunities for staff
2. Explore opportunities to partner with Spruce Grove and Stony Plain through the Tri-Municipal Regional Plan work
3. Engage with Indigenous neighbours to understand their perspectives on meaningful engagement and reconciliation
