



- Aligns to Strategic Plan 2016-2020.





BUILT ENVIRONMENT (LAND USE)

A state in which the community's built environment meets community needs, now and in the future.

We will:

Plan, build, operate, and maintain the built environment for community needs in such a way that ensures public safety, innovative and efficient land and material use, and balances longevity with costs.

MDP Guiding Principle

BUILT ENVIRONMENT (LAND USE)

The County will plan, build, operate and maintain the built environment to ensure public safety and to meet community needs by using innovation in its practices and balancing infrastructure longevity with cost.



NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

A state in which the demands placed on the natural environment can be met without reducing its capacity to allow living things to live well, now and in the future.

We will:

- 1. Promote renewables and the responsible use of non-renewable resources.
- 2. Eliminate the non-essential use of synthetic substances.
- 3. Minimize destruction of the environment.
- 4. Undertake restoration and enhancement activities.

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

The County will conserve and enhance the natural environment by minimizing environmental destruction, undertaking restoration activities, promoting renewable resources and reducing non-renewable resource use.
