<p><b>PURPOSE</b></p> <p>Parkland County recognizes that playschools are an important element in the socialization of children. This policy establishes that playschools located within the County may be eligible to be added as an additional named insured under the County's liability insurance policy at subsidized rates, subject to budget approval.</p> <p><b>POLICY</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Playschools, to be recognized by the County, must have a rural base, and 75% of the registrants must be County residents.</li><li>2. The Department will be available on a consulting basis to assist the playschools with their operation.</li><li>3. The recognized playschools will be listed as "additional named insured" on Parkland County's liability insurance policy.</li><li>4. The playschools must pay the additional named insured premiums for the liability insurance policy, as stipulated by Parkland County. Subsidization may be provided to a maximum of 50%, subject to budget approval.</li><li>5. The playschool must meet all Social Services, Health and Fire regulations.</li><li>6. Each playschool will have an instructor and executive manual which contain guidelines for the operation of a playschool.</li><li>7. A playschool is eligible for funding with a minimum of six registrants.</li></ol>
