

Topic: Rescinding Parkland County Bylaw 2022-07

Introduction:

With the approval of Bylaw 2023-16, Parks bylaw, Administration completed a review of other bylaws to ensure alignment with the approved bylaw. In this review, Bylaw 2022-07 was identified as no longer required and recommended to be rescinded.

Background Information:

Parkland County initiated a major bylaw review update. Bylaw 2023-16 was updated and approved on Oct 24, 2023. With the approval of Bylaw 2023-16, Parks bylaw, Administration completed a review of our other policies and bylaws to ensure alignment. The following bylaw was identified as being redundant and the intent was captured within the park's bylaw.

- Bylaw 2022-07 – use of parking and launch areas at Waterfront Park
