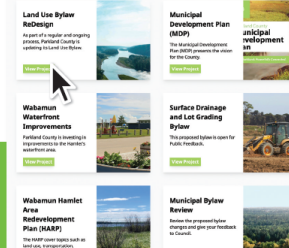
Decisions made by Council are improved through open and transparent processes including the input and feedback of residents. We've launched a public engagement portal to give residents a chance to learn about and **provide** input.

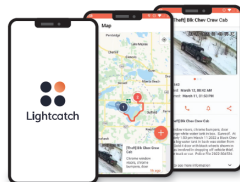
There's also an Enforcement page that keeps you updated on significant criminal activity, crime prevention programs, and connects you to a peace officer to anonymously ask questions.

Lightcatch

Lightcatch is an effective crime-fighting tool that has been proven to lower crime rates by bringing the community together in a digital version of neighbourhood watch.

What's the secret?

The more people using Lightcatch, the more effective it is!



How it works:

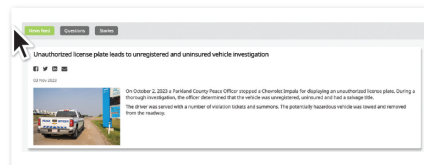
Spot a crime in progress or suspicious activity?

- 1 Report it in the app! You can remain anonymous, add photos, and even upload security video to your post. Lightcatch verifies all alerts and posts so that only accurate information goes out to users.
- 2 An alert goes out to all users in the area. Other users can update on the original post with sightings or additional details in real time.
- 3 Law Enforcement can use the info to track, investigate, and possibly apprehend any offenders.
