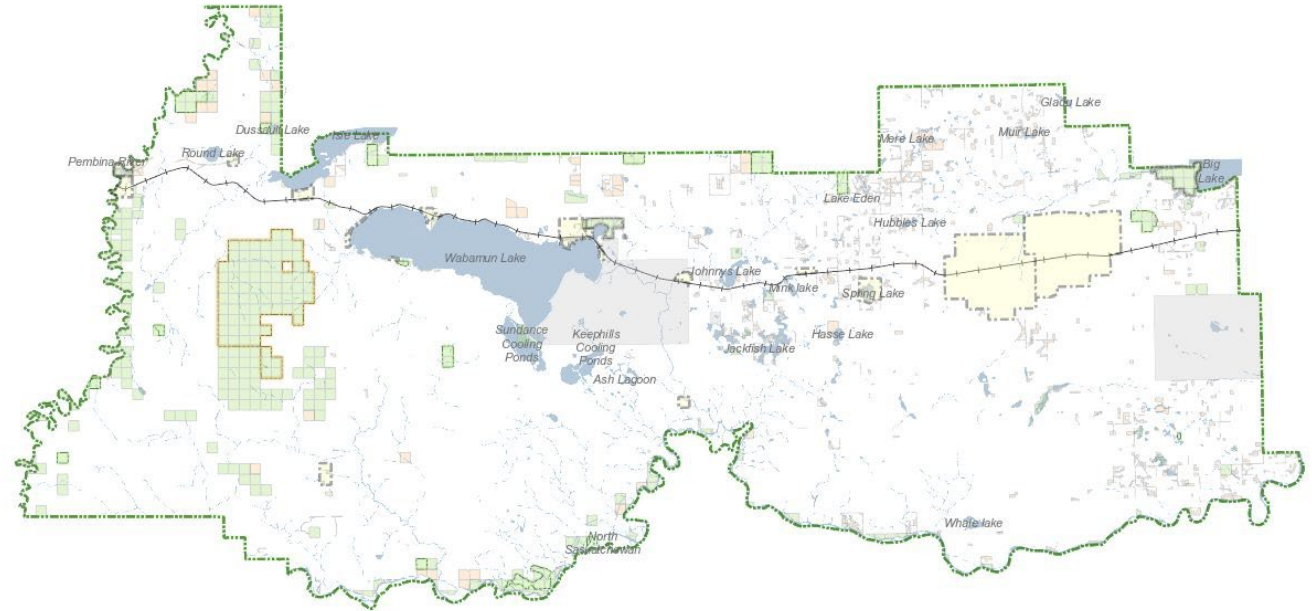

# Operations

Preservation and maintenance of  
Parkland County roads and  
drainage infrastructure and the  
production of aggregate products



# Infrastructure

- 1,250 kms of gravel roads
- 892 kms of paved surfaces
- 4,500 kms of ditching and licensed drainage course
- Bridges, storm ponds, lift stations and underground stormwater infrastructure
- Aggregate exploration, extraction and reclamation

# Road Maintenance

01

## Spring Maintenance

- Dust control complete by June 30
- 92 kms of street sweeping completed
- 140 kms of winter graveling



02

## Summer Maintenance

- 22.5 kms of shoulder pull planned
- 300 km of line painting
- Utilize Infrared patching trailer
- Testing asphalt millings in dust control applications







# Drainage

01

## Spring

- 209 drainage-related calls YTD
- Sweeping 36 span bridges
- Brushing in Twin Ravines, Golden Spike and RR 35

02

## Summer

- 3 centreline replacements
- 15 culvert replacements
- 40-50 inspections and required maintenance
- Bridge deck replacements



# Aggregate

01

## Spring

- Exposed and crushed 85,000 tonnes of aggregate
- Mixed 38,000 tonnes of ASBC for Road Maintenance and Engineering
- Submitted application for Burtonsville Pit



02

## Summer

- Commissioning for Burtsonville Pit
- Complete final extraction stages of Bamber Pit
- Reclamation activities
