16	Light or caused to be lit a fire within an Industrial land district	\$500	\$1 000
17	Light fire without permit	\$250	\$500
20	Disclose false information when applying for a Fire Permit	\$500	\$1 000
26 (1)	Contravene any term or condition of a permit issued pursuant to this Bylaw	\$250	\$500
34 (1)	When a Fire Restriction is in place, no Person shall ignite any fire unless the fire is exempt from requiring a permit	\$500	\$1 000

39	Ignite fire or discharge fireworks during a fire ban	\$500	\$1 000
41	Distribute, offer for sale, store, sell, use, discharge, fire or set off Fireworks or pyrotechnics displays within Parkland County without a valid Fireworks Permit.	\$250	\$500
44	Sell low hazard recreational fireworks within the County to any person under the age of 18 years.	\$500	\$500
53	Sell consumer fireworks within Parkland County, except on New Year's Day and Canada Day or the 14 days immediately preceding New Year's Day and Canada Day.	\$500	\$500
58	Failure to immediately report a release of Dangerous goods to Fire Services on public or private land	\$500	\$1 000
84	No person shall interfere with or obstruct a Peace Officer in the exercise of their powers and duties pursuant to this bylaw.	\$500	\$2 500
