<p><b>PURPOSE AND INTENT</b></p> <p>To control the spread of fire blight in the County.</p> <p><b>POLICY STATEMENT</b></p> <p>If any trees are found to have fire blight, they shall be cut down and burned at the landowner's expense as per the Agricultural Pest Act.</p> <p>Trees most commonly infected:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Mountain Ash.</li><li>2. Apple.</li><li>3. Cottoneaster.</li></ol>
