

Occupational Health and Safety External COR Audit Results

The following information is being presented for *information purposes*.

Between April 10 and 17, Parkland County underwent its external certificate of recognition audit. This audit is the standard for the certificate of recognition (COR as it is commonly known as) for employers who develop Health and Safety programs. Certificates are issued by Certifying Partners (in our case – AMHSA – Alberta Municipal Health and Safety Association) and are cosigned by Alberta Human Services.

Achieving and maintaining a valid COR requires an audit mark of 80% or higher.

Parkland County is please present a final mark was 98%; this is up from the previous external audit held in 2010 where we scored 94.8%.
