BYLAW NO. 2015-20

BEING A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW NO. 63-2003, BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH WARD BOUNDARIES FOR PARKLAND COUNTY, TO ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS TO BE ELECTED TO SERVE ON PARKLAND COUNTY COUNCIL AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION OF THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL BY THE ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY

WHEREAS Section 148(2) of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, enables a council to pass a bylaw to change the ward boundaries for the County; and

WHEREAS Section 63(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, provides that a council may by bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Parkland County duly assembled and under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, hereby enacts the following:


1. That the boundaries of Division 4 and Division 5 be amended so that Marrakesh Properties subdivision, in its entirety, be included in Division 4.
2. That the map titled as Schedule "A", which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw, replace the map titled as Schedule "A" to Bylaw No. 63-2003.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of third reading and signing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME this 26th day of May, 2015.

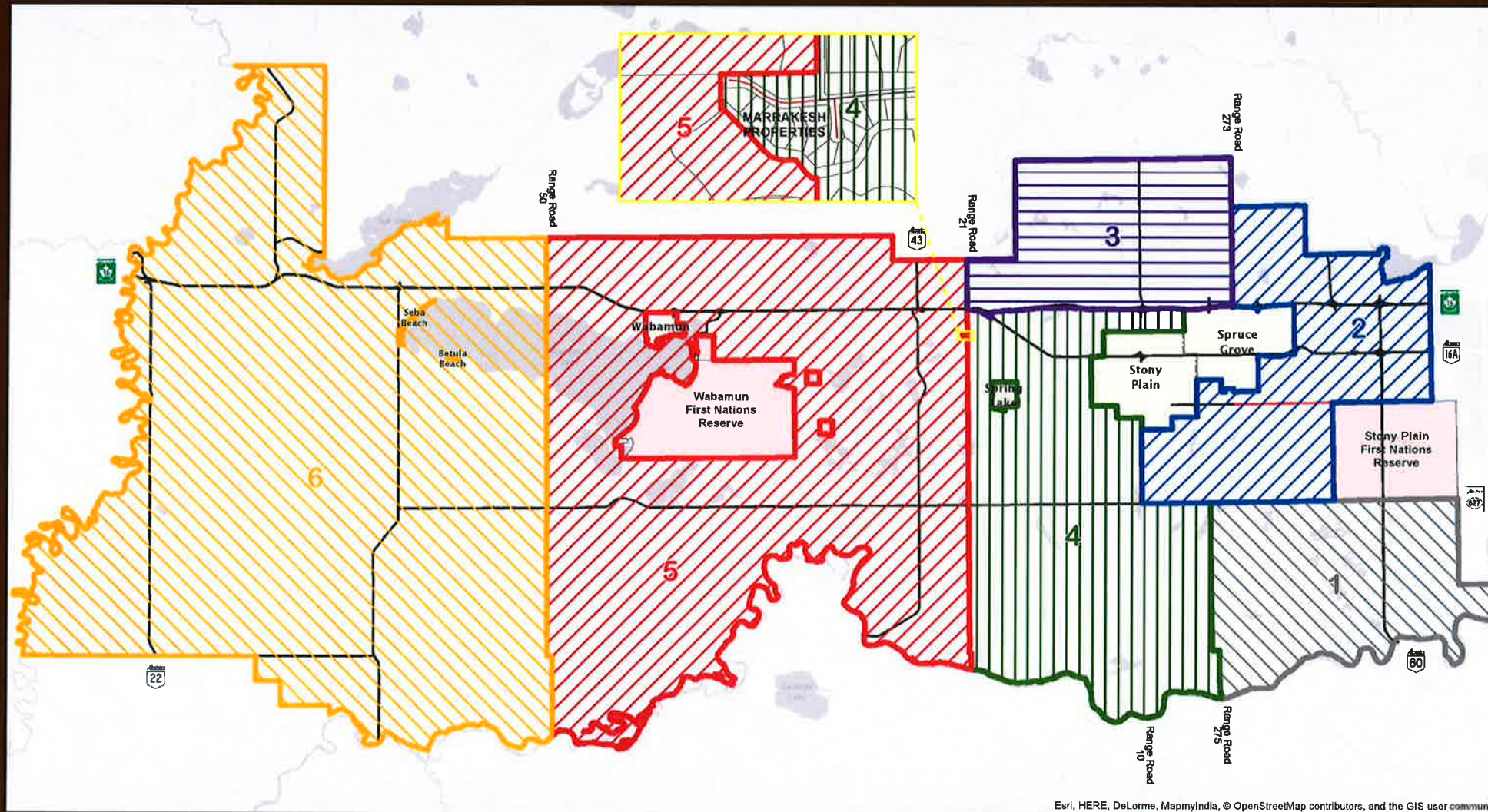
READ A SECOND TIME this 26th day of May, 2015.
