
Q3 REPORT SUMMARY

 - Focus discussion on variances: 85% < utilization < 65%






GENERAL OPERATING ACTIVITY





GENERAL OPERATING ACTIVITY - REVENUE


Base Program Operating Revenues








Financial Assets






Long Term Debt






Tangible Capital Assets
