Goals & Objectives

Goal 1

Align Policies

Create a land use planning policy structure that is predictable, easy to maintain, and consistently applied throughout the County.

Goal 2

Streamline Services

Ensure that each ASP in the County contains the appropriate level of policy detail to enable a streamlined development process.

Goal 3

Flexibility/Adaptability

Make ASPs living documents that manage risk for the County and provide opportunities/transparency to applicants that identify “hard no’s” early in the process while always working towards “how can we get to a yes?”

Goal 4

User Friendliness

Write ASPs that are approachable to the general public and adaptable to the changing economic environment.




Development Area Policies

- Areas with most development pressure and complexity






Figure 4. Development Concept Map





General support for the project and alignment with the ideas floated in the consultant findings



Emphasis on modernizing this level of our Planning Hierarchy and making ASPs easier to use and more consistent across each plan



Support for removing or shrinking plans that are not useful, misalign with MDP/LUB, or are repetitive with a Local Plan



General lack of awareness of the purpose of ASPs / their existence



East side ASPs favoured for tackling first based on development pressure and how often they are used
