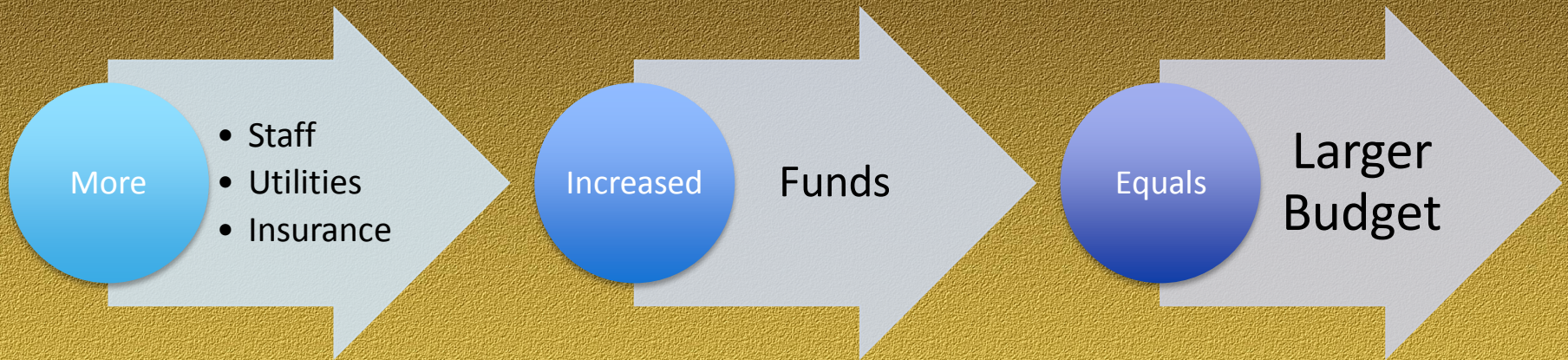








# The Result
