Summary of Carlson Sand and Gravel Movements before approved haul times:

Received on 2012/09/29. Complainant had contacted Parkland County Enforcement Services. Peace Officer HUDSON received the file. BACKSTROM conducted the follow up.

Complaint received is of trucks on the road before the 0730 hrs stipulated in the haul agreement.

The Complainant could not indicate ASGA truck #. BACKSTROM spoke with Paul CARLSON in relation to this file. CARLSON denied the trucks early on the road came from his pit. BACKSTROM reminded the hours of the haul agreement on a Saturday.

This file was deemed unfounded because there was insufficient evidence to support the allegations.

Case Report 2012-2494

On Saturday October 20, 2012 Gravel Point Peace Officer BACKSTROM and Operational Supervisor HERITAGE conducted a proactive patrol of the gravel operations on Rge Rd 44/43 south of Hwy 627. The patrol is in response to recent complaints of trucks entering onto the haul road prior to allowable time.

At 0655 hrs BACKSTROM arrived at Rge Rd 44 at the intersection of Hwy 627. There were two gravel trucks parked on Rge Rd 44, just south of the Hwy 627 intersection. These trucks were parked in the south bound lanes, forcing any vehicles travelling south bound to go into the opposite lane on a hill.

One truck was displaying an ASGA (Alberta Sand and Gravel Association) # 6354, the other truck did not have an ASGA number displayed. BACKSTROM spoke with both drivers of the vehicles. The drivers had advised BACKSTROM they were operating for Carlson Sand and Gravel. The drivers advised they were told to park on the road and wait until the pit operators came and got them.

1505658 AB LTD had entered into an Industrial Haul agreement with Parkland County. Within this haul agreement are the haul operation hours. On a Saturday the company is permitted to haul from 8 am until 4 pm. The company may proceed to pit ½ hour prior to the stipulated hours of haul.

The two vehicles which intended to proceed to the 1505658 AB LTD. (Carlson Sand and Gravel). These trucks were located on the haul road at 0655 hrs, 35 minutes before the haul agreement permits trucks to proceed to the pit.
