Project Title	HVAC Upgrades,
Introduction	Clymont Community League is an extremely active Community League, hosting a multitude of programs, special events, and hall rentals each year. The Community League is a very diverse group with a strong pool of volunteers and the facility, and the outdoor amenities are extremely well utilized. The HVAC upgrades will further sustain the life of the facility.
The Project	Large-scale heating, ventilation, and air conditioning upgrades in the hall. The new equipment will conform to current standards of energy efficiency and environmental sustainability.
Program Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • North Furnace/AHU replacement • South furnace / AC replacement • Boiler replacement – possible refurbishment • Automated controls system • Yearly maintenance agreement
Site Factors/ Considerations	No other extraordinary site factors beyond timing for the closure of the facility to the public and patron use, although supply availability may be a factor in the start and completion dates.
Financial Resources	\$62,5000 in cash savings plus donations and volunteer time from Clymont Community League members. Cost estimates are based on quotes received in 2024. If they do not receive the grant from Parkland County, and other sources then the project will be scaled back and completed in phases as funds are available.
Approvals Required	Approvals/inspections required are the responsibility of the Clymont Community League to meet industry and Parkland County permits.
Implementation Responsibilities	The Project will be overseen by Clymont Community League. Contractors will be utilized where needed to complete the project.
Proposed Schedule	The proposed schedule is partially dependent upon notification of successful grant applications and weather. Ideally, the commencement date is estimated to be fall 2025 with completion depending upon the amount of grants and funding secured.
