- North and South Highway 759 Entrances to Tomahawk (Precise locations to be confirmed with Power/Road allowance, specification's and Alberta Infrastructures)
- Parkland County Public owned properties (Green Spaces) within the Hamlet of Tomahawk, Alberta
- Street Poles from North to South end of Tomahawk Centre area
- Sidewalk edging of Tomahawk, in particular Business Frontages
- Agriplex: Initially the Boulevard & Entry Gates. Further discussion with the Agricultural Society is needed to clarify their needs/interests for enhancement locations within the grounds. Walking Trails, Picnic / Camping areas have been discussed.
- Dog friendly area for residents and Travellers: Location to be determined (Parkland County Green space)

 - General 'Clean Up' for example: Electrical/Cable boxes straightened, painted




Tomahawk Beautification Initiative - Project Detail


















Location: Hwy 759 on West Boulevard outside Agriplex Fence line & Gate Entries
