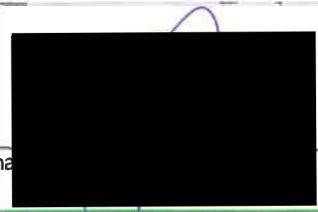

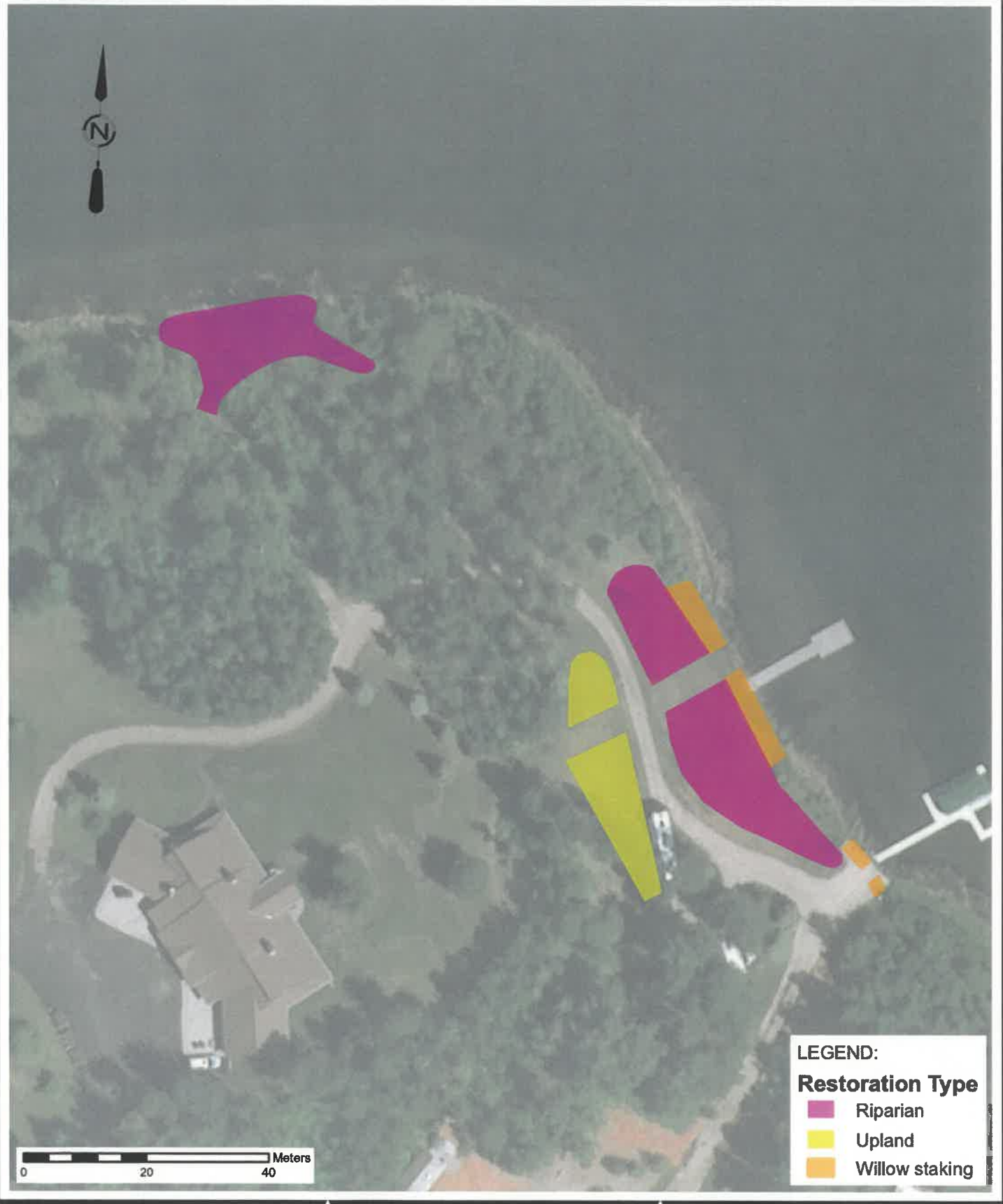

Restoration activities are planned for the 2023 growing season and include the development of a visually aesthetic, low-maintenance plant community by installing native trees and shrubs that reduce the risk of shoreline erosion, improve fish and wildlife habitat, provide water quality improvement, biodiversity support and carbon sequestration.
