#### **PURPOSE**

To provide an open and transparent process for individual members of Council to hold meetings with members of the development community or with anyone who wishes to propose a development to Parkland County.

#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

Members of County Council recognize that their behavior, both publicly and privately, will be under scrutiny from residents. Given that Council has expressed its desire to be not only fair but to be seen as fair, Council has determined that individual Council members may meet with current and prospective developers, only in accordance with the standards set out in this policy.

### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to members of Parkland County Council.

#### **STANDARDS**

- 1. Council members are entitled to meet in County offices or off-site with prospective developers at the request of the developer.
- 2. Council members will immediately inform the CAO and Mayor of such request so that these can be monitored in terms of their frequency, and from which developers such requests are being made.
- 3. Council members are not entitled to make any commitments to any proposed development or developer nor to provide the developer with access to any information which is not publicly available.
- 4. If a developer makes a request to be heard by Council-in-whole, such a request will be passed on to the office of the Manager, Legislative & Administrative Services, and further contact on an individual basis by a member of Council will cease.
- No commitments will be made by any member of Council to any developer to do anything other than
  consider any request for development on its merits and at the same time as all other members of
  Council.
