

Operating Program Expenditure (Excluding Accounting Reclass)




Budget Changes

- \$455,500 increase in Water and Wastewater revenue and expense budget to reflect the revised consumption volume and rates
- \$30,000 increase in Council per diems and mileage to match the historical trend



OPERATING PROJECT BUDGET

Operating Project Budget (Excluding Accounting Reclass)



Budget Changes

- Addition of \$59,800 for Contaminated Site Assessments
- Addition of \$175,000 for Information Services Department
- Addition of \$65,000 for 2023
 Edmonton Metropolitan Region
 Board (EMRB) golf tournament.
 Anticipated revenue is \$48,000
- Other minor projects correction adds up to \$3,300 reduction



CAPITAL PROJECT BUDGET

Capital Budget Project Budget (Excluding Accounting Reclass)



Budget Changes

- Deferral of the \$4 million portion of the Entwistle Water Treatment Plant replacement to 2024
- Moved \$120,000 Emerging Capital (Acheson initiatives) to 2024 to align the budget updated cash flow projection
- Addition of \$52,800 Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) grant funded Wabamun utility project
- Addition of \$80,000 for Council Chambers Audio Visual Technology

(Financial assets after deducting the County's liabilities)

Monthly tax increase for median home owner, assuming no increase in property value

Individual tax impacts will vary based on property value changes that occurred in 2022. These changes include market value adjustments and development on the property

For instance - a median homeowner with a market increase of 4% may see a total tax increase of about \$11 per month
