





NEW MEDICATION HEMORRHAGE CONTROL

STARS has bolstered its medical toolkit with an innovative new blood product to help form blood clots and assist with hemorrhage control.

- Increase to 4 units of blood onboard
- Utilized in severe trauma cases
- Patients requiring more than two units of blood
- Fibrinogen promotes blood clots to form
