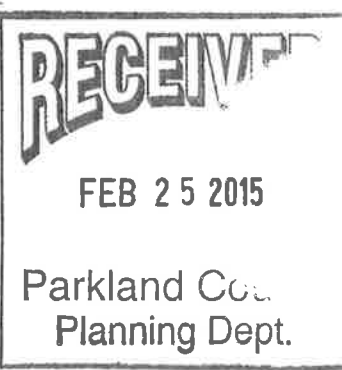

we have discussed the issue of rezoning adjoining land still
being Agricultural / Nature Conservation. Our quarter SE 31-51
R7-W5 is still under that Bylaw. In the event the above mention
quarter is rezoned we would want the same for ours. That
