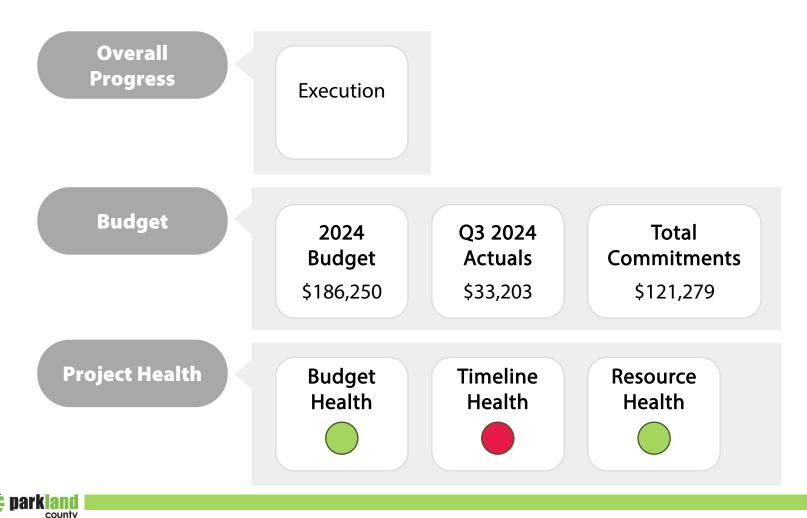


# RURAL INTERNET INITIATIVES (2024-2027)

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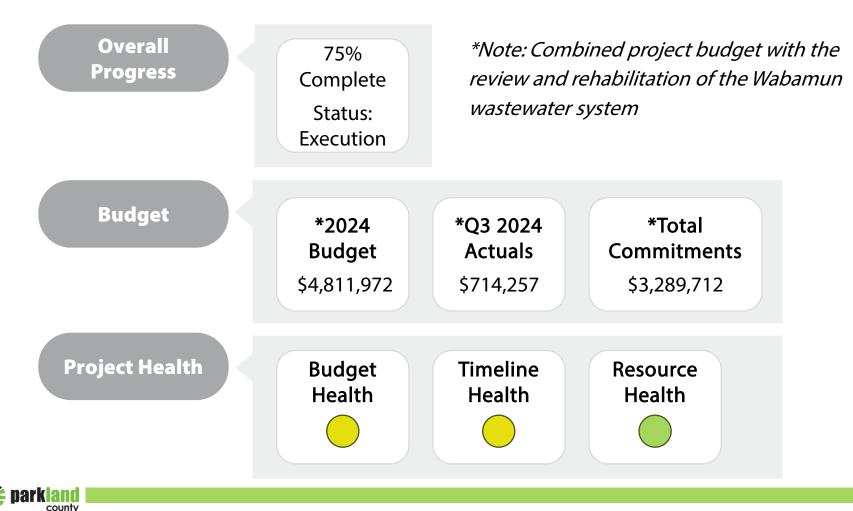



Wabamun Wastewater System Review and infrastructure project to rehabilitate the existing wastewater lagoon in Wabamun.

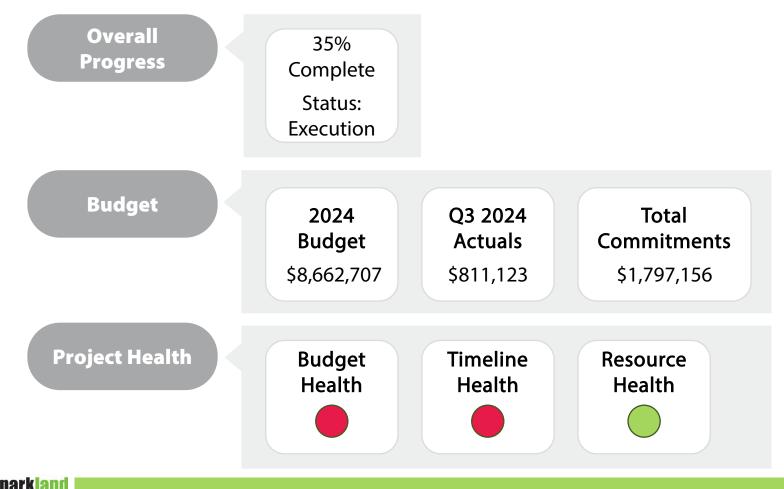


#### WATERFRONT AREA IMPROVEMENTS (2024-2026)

*Priority Strategy: Review and update the County's framework on environmentally significant areas to support responsible management of natural assets and amenities.* 

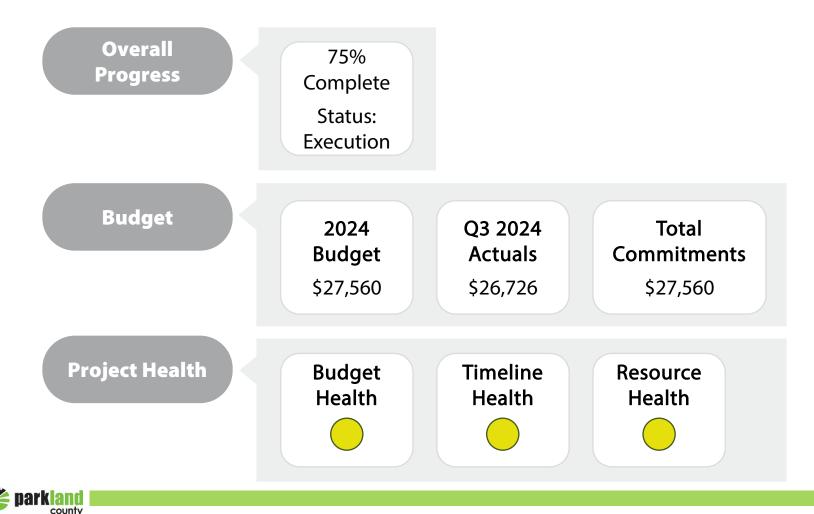



*Priority Strategy (D2): Communicate and engage meaningfully with County residents on matters of importance to them using methods that work for them.* 



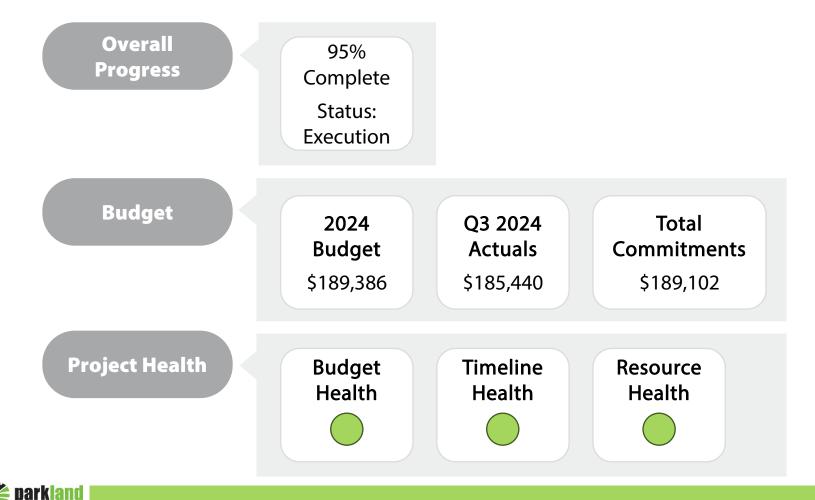

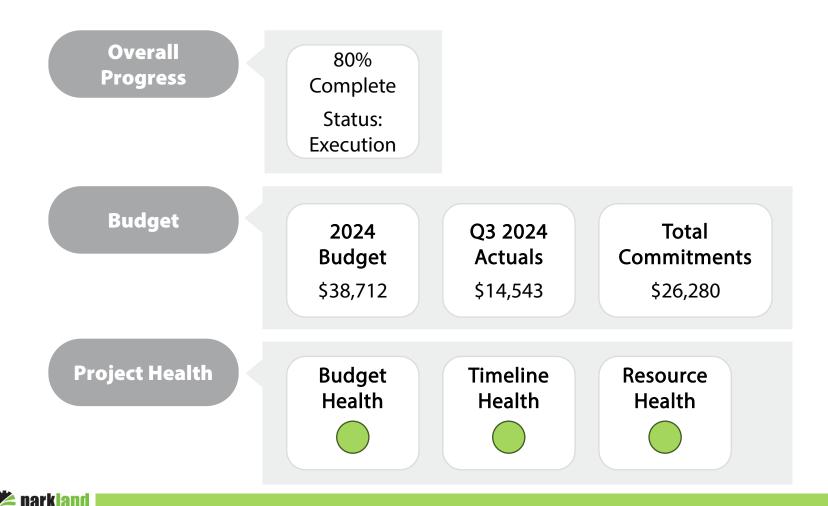


