Hi Janna,

Thank you again for the opportunity to comment on the proposed ASP amendment.

The suggested revision to the proposed amendment area will reduce the land area affected and will concentrate the amendment area in the NW portion of the subject area. This revision does not change the content of the letter from Peter Ohm, dated April 5, 2013. As noted in that letter, we do not object to the amendment itself since it is of a technical nature, although we do have some concern with the possible zoning and associated uses allowed under the amendment. The broader long term issue relates to the fragmentation of land and how it may impede the possible orderly expansion of the adjacent PGA boundary westward. Reducing the amendment area as suggested does not change the principle underlying this concern.

As we have suggested in previous meetings, there is now a record of concern that Edmonton has expressed all along our shared boundary in this vicinity, and therefore we invite Parkland County to once again engage in a more comprehensive formal planning discussion to consider future development in these areas.
