

PARKLAND COUNTY
BYLAW NO. 24-2012

BEING A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESCINDING INOPERATIVE
AND INEFFECTIVE BYLAWS THAT ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED

WHEREAS the Council of Parkland County wishes to pass a bylaw pursuant to Section 63(2)(b) of the *Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, 2000*, as amended, for the purpose of rescinding bylaws that are inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent, or otherwise ineffective, and

WHEREAS Section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act* specifies that the repeal of a bylaw must be made in the same way as the original bylaw, and

WHEREAS the following bylaws are inoperative, obsolete, expired, and otherwise ineffective,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Parkland County enacts that the following bylaws are hereby rescinded:
