## BEING A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESCINDING INOPERATIVE AND INEFFECTIVE BYLAWS THAT ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED

WHEREAS the Council of Parkland County wishes to pass a bylaw pursuant to Section 63(2)(b) of the *Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, 2000*, as amended, for the purpose of rescinding bylaws that are inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent, or otherwise ineffective, and
