

# Intention

---

- **Partners to include Parkland County, NSWA, Alberta Environment and Parks, Wabamun summer villages, Industry, and others**
- **implementation to begin in 2017**
- **NSWA maintains the plan**
- **Leadership and implementation responsibilities to be shared by the Partnership**

# Timeline

---

- **Joint Partners' committee struck by December 2016**
- **Agreement on Terms of Reference: Winter 2016**
- **First Work plan: early spring**
- **Implementation on key actions to start in Summer 2017**

# Request of Parkland County Council

---

- **Participation of Parkland County in discussions with Alberta Environment and Parks, Summer Villages, WWMC, NSWA, and other parties on what actions can be undertaken to protect Wabamun Lake (admin staff time for meetings).**
- **Decisions on further involvement can be taken after the TOR is accepted and details of the plan are assembled.**

# Value to Parkland County

- **Accumulated advice on actions for Wabamun Lake may provide valuable material for inter-municipal development plan, the WLSLUP, and other County planning initiatives.**
- **The Watershed Plan can help achieve outcomes outlined in the WLSLUP**
