

## **September 13, 2013 Board Meeting Highlights**

- An update of the Source Control Program was given to the Board. Since 2009, the ACRWC has advanced the program in conjunction with our member municipalities. Looking forward, the program will evolve to include: a review the screening and inspection criteria; the development of more educational material; and, the potential to develop Codes of Practice and Best Management Practice guides.
- The Board approved a set of Guiding Principles for the negotiation of a new Biosolids Management Agreement with the City of Edmonton. The current agreement expires in 2015. The new agreement will align with the Regional Biosolids Management Plan developed jointly between the City of Edmonton and ACRWC.
- Building on the success of the Grant Eligibility Communication and Advocacy Committee, the Board approved terms of reference for a Communication and Advocacy Committee. Once the need for an advocacy strategy is determined by the Board for a particular matter, the Committee will oversee the development and execution the strategy.
