We would like to recognize your dedication to the environment with your decision to purchase 20% Green Power as part of your total annual electricity consumption in the 2009 AMSC Energy Program. Enclosed you will find your Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) acknowledging your renewable energy purchase for January to December 2012.

TransAlta is an EcoLogo™ Licensee as a marketer and generator of Renewable Low Impact Electricity through Environment Canada's Environmental Choice Program. Our facilities meet EcoLogo® verification standards and our product is verified by independent third parties that validate the source, quality and amount of correlating clean energy. These certificates entitle you to all the rights, title, interest and benefits resulting from the actual (or assumed) displacement of emissions through electricity production at a green power facility. TransAlta generates Green Energy by harnessing one of the best renewable energy sources on earth; the wind. Your green power purchase displaces emissions from coal and gas-fired generation, lowering air contaminants such as sulphur dioxide, nitrogen oxide and greenhouse gases.

Parkland County's purchase of 539 MWh of green power has contributed to the reduction of 474.36 tonnes of carbon dioxide, which is similar to taking 93 cars off the road for one year or planting 12,144 trees. Your choice has offset a significant amount of the greenhouse gases produced while generating your electricity; thank you!

With your 2009 Energy contract approaching the end of its term on December 31, 2013, AMSC has developed an enhanced 2014 Energy Program which will continue to be an environmentally responsible, transparent and flexible program in which you will again have the option to acquire green power.
