

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

Topic: Proposed Bylaw No. 2014-02, being a Bylaw of Parkland County for the purpose of repealing the Safety Codes Services Permit Bylaw (Bylaw No. 02-2007).

Introduction:

Parkland County's current Safety Codes Services Permit Bylaw is both duplicated and overruled by the Provincial Safety Codes Act 2000 being Chapter S-1 Revised Statutes of Alberta last consolidated December 10, 2012 and the Provincial Safety Codes Act, Permit Regulation, Alberta Regulation 204/2007 that came into force on April 1, 2008. Therefore Bylaw 02-2007 is obsolete.

Facts (Background Information):

Parkland County Safety Codes Services Permit Bylaw 02-2007 was passed on March 13, 2007. Those policies that are duplicated by the Safety Codes Act of 2000 were drafted unnecessarily. After the Provincial Safety Codes Act, Permit Regulation, Alberta Regulation 204/2007 came into force on April 1, 2008 the remainder of the policies within this bylaw were either duplicated or overruled. Therefore Bylaw 02-2007 is now obsolete and redundant.

Administration recommends that Bylaw No. 02-2007 be repealed.

Alternatives:

- 1. Council may table first reading of Bylaw 2014-02 and request Administration to provide additional information.
- Council may defeat Bylaw 2014-02 at first reading

Conclusion/Summary:

Administration supports this repeal as proposed in Bylaw 2014-02.
