AHS Continues to Make Progress on 10-Point Plan

As AHS EMS continues to manage a sustained and significant increase in 911 calls, its implementation of all items in the EMS 10-Point Plan is helping to address these continued system pressures, creating capacity within the EMS system. Progress on each of the initiatives is outlined below, and they continue to update the AHS EMS website. However, some of the key updates include: new ambulances in both Edmonton and Calgary, continued diversion of appropriate calls to Poison and Drug Information Services, conclusion of one pilot project in Calgary, progression of pilot project in Red Deer and \$12.2M of funding approved for workforce initiatives.
