

Topic: Animal Control Bylaw 2013-16

Introduction:

On May 7, 2013 the Governance and Priorities Committee directed Administration to present Animal Control Bylaw 02-2012 to Council May 28, 2013. As Animal Control Bylaw 02-2012 had not received any reading by Council in 2012, Administration has renumbered it to 2013-16. There have been no other change to what was presented to the Governance and Priorities Committee on May 7, 2013.

This bylaw provides regulation and control of household pets, animals and birds.
