As a long-time resident of Jackfish Lake, I am strongly opposed to the proposed change to the Land Use Bylaw by developers of a new 75 lot subdivision, of which 30 will be lakefront.

The government has already limited boat traffic and enforced environmental restrictions to protect the water quality and reserve land, as well as human safety. Allowing 30 more docks and unlimited watercraft is contradictory to laws already in place.

Jackfish Lake is for all to enjoy, people, animals, plants, insects, but overpopulating could be detrimental to an already fragile ecosystem.
