POLICY C-AD53

- ► To be supported by directives and procedures on individual land activity functions.
- Follows the county's new policy framework.
- Activity under Policy C-AD53 will continue to be managed in accordance with current legislation and be supported by internal policies and bylaws.
- Will replace policies that look at individual aspects of land management, combining into one governing policy. This ensures transparency and consistency.

- Acquisition of land
- Management of land
- Disposal of land





ACQUISITION OF LAND

- Council will approve budget for all Acquisition of Land for County infrastructure, recreation and operational purposes;
 Policy EN 015 – Purchase of Land for Municipal and Public Use.
- Acquiring of Lease, License or Permit to Occupy Lands will require Council approval unless within the scope of an approved project.





MANAGEMENT OF LAND

- Agricultural Licensing Program
- Leases of Road Allowances closed by Municipal Bylaw
- Temporary Authorization of Use
- Surface Leases on County Land
- Community Association Licenses of Occupation
- Compliance Reviews
- Management of County held Leases and License of Occupation
- Management of properties obtained through Tax Forfeiture



DISPOSAL OF LAND

- Sale of Municipal Reserve Land under *Policy C-PD16* Municipal Reserve Disposition
- Sale of Properties obtained under Section 419 of the MGA
 Tax Forfeitures
- Sale of Road Allowances closed by Municipal Bylaw under *Policy EN-009* – Road Allowances & Diversions – Sale, Lease or Permitting
- The marketing and sale of county land must comply with Administrative Directive A-AD03 – Sale of Properties
