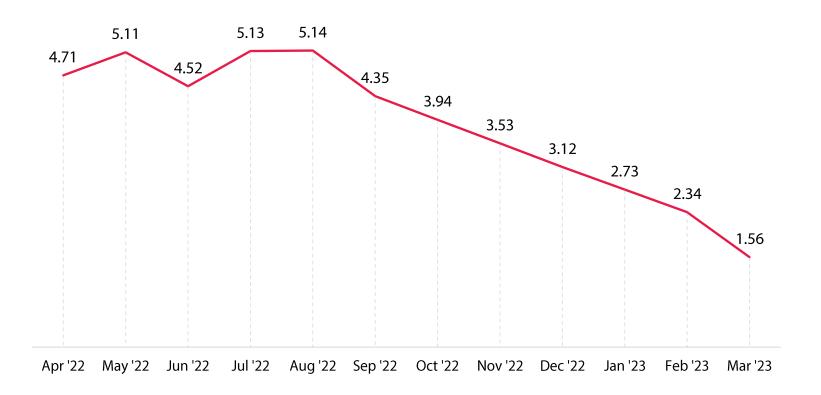

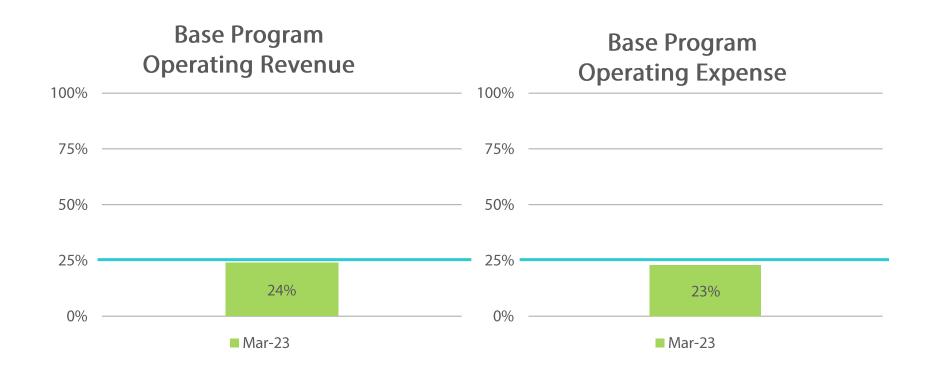

  - Variances greater than 35% or less than 15% will be discussed





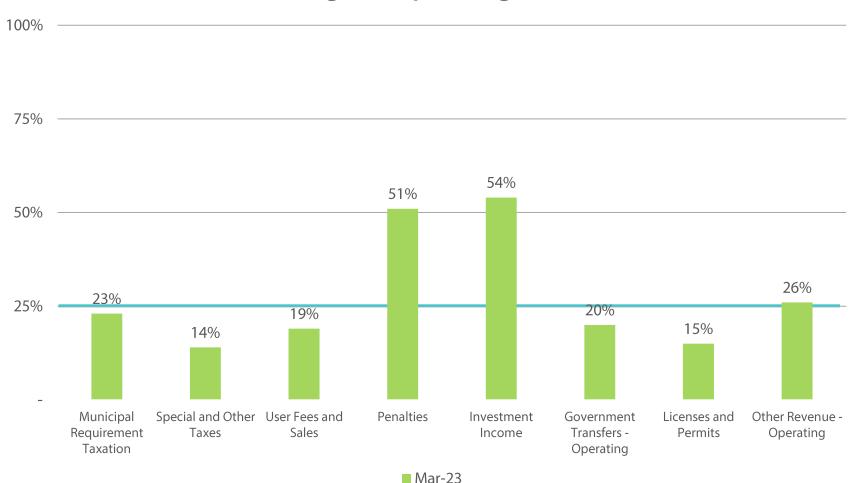

### **GENERAL OPERATING ACTIVITY - REVENUE**

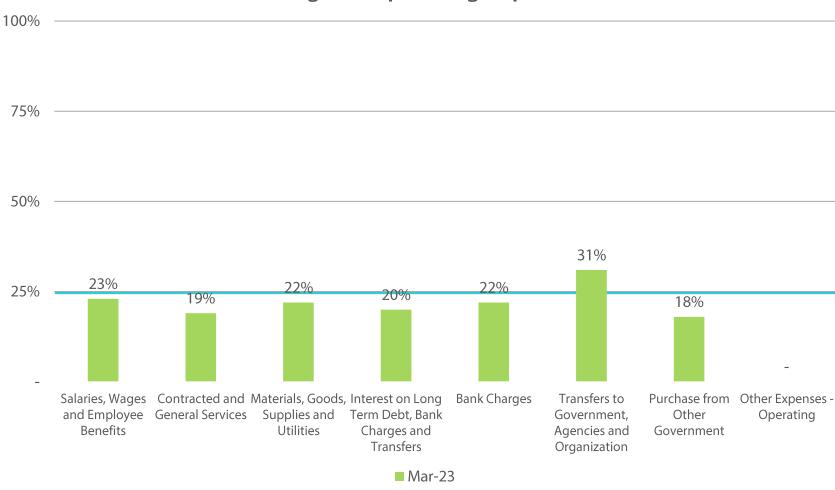
### **Base Program Operating Revenues**

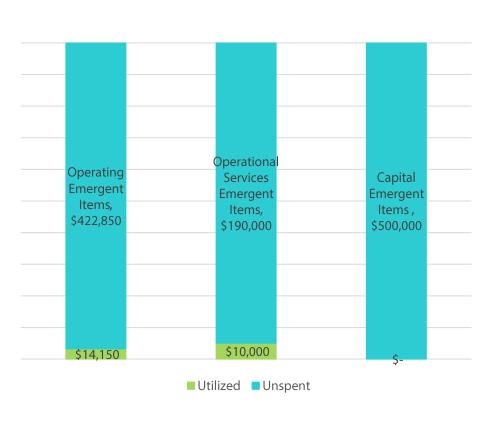

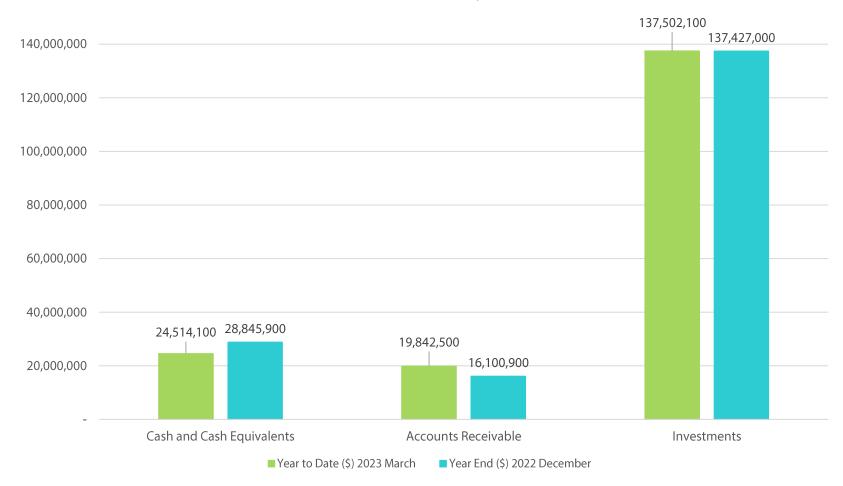

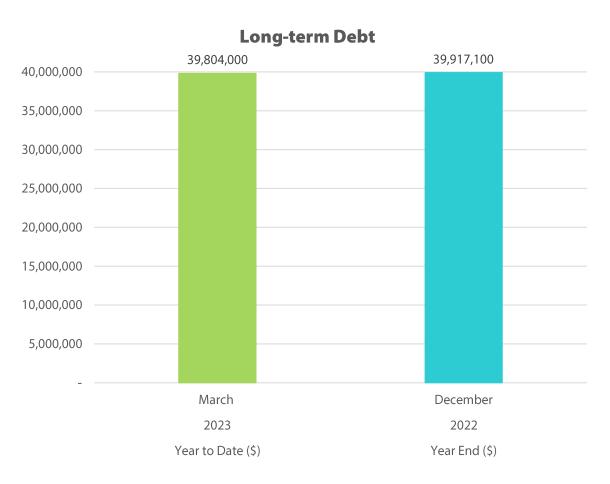

### **Cash Flow Analysis**

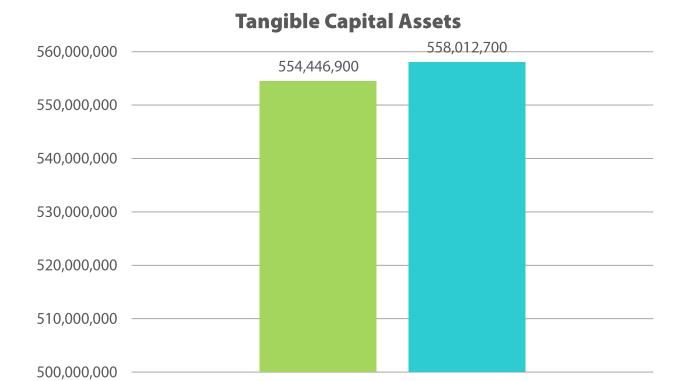






- Q1 long-term debt <u>decrease</u>

  - Maximum allowable debt: \$140,956,308

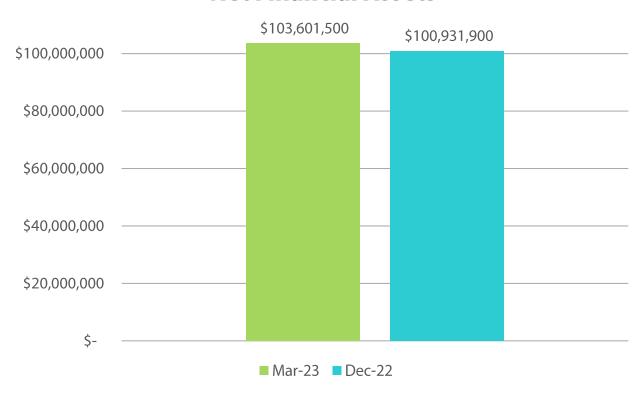
