

## **ENHANCED POLICING AGREEMENT – GRAVEL ENFORCEMENT**

### **POLICING PERFORMANCE PLAN**

#### **SCHEDULE “A”**

**AS PER ITEM 3. OF THE ENHANCED POLICING AGREEMENT DATED JULY 25, 2013, AND SIGNED BY WILLIAM SWEENEY, ASSISTANT DEPUTY MINISTER PUBLIC SECURITY, ALBERTA JUSTICE & SOLICITOR GENERAL, THIS DOCUMENT IS THE “POLICING PERFORMANCE PLAN.”**

**RESPONSIBILITIES OF RCMP SPRUCE GROVE/STONY PLAIN DETACHMENT MEMBERS AND PEACE OFFICERS OF PARKLAND COUNTY.**

#### **RCMP SPRUCE GROVE/STONY PLAIN:**

- 1. WILL PROVIDE ENHANCED PATROLS AND TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT SPECIFIC TO GRAVEL HAUL OPERATIONS WITHIN PARKLAND COUNTY**
- 2. PARKLAND COUNTY WILL IDENTIFY THE DAY OF THE WEEK AND THE HOURS TO BE COVERED ONE MONTH IN ADVANCE**
- 3. THE MEMBER WILL LIAISE WITH PARKLAND COUNTY ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AT THE START OF HIS/HER SHIFT**
- 4. THE MEMBER WILL COMPLETE THE PARKLAND COUNTY ENFORCEMENT SERVICES TRUCK FORM FOR EACH GRAVEL TRUCK STOPPED**
  - a. ATTACHED AS APPENDIX “A”**
- 5. THE INFORMATION TO BE CAPTURED ON THE TRUCK FORM INCLUDES THE ASGA (ALBERTA SAND & GRAVEL ASSOC) NUMBER, THE DRIVER, THE COMPANY HAULING FOR, WHETHER THE TRUCK IS LOADED OR EMPTY AND DIRECTION OF TRAVEL AT TIME OF STOP**
- 6. THE MEMBER AT THE END OF HIS/HER SHIFT WILL PLACE ALL PAPERWORK IN THE ASSIGNED BASKET AS DETERMINED BY S/SGT BILL EUBANK**
- 7. THIS INFORMATION IS TO BE PICKED UP BY PARKLAND COUNTY ENFORCEMENT SERVICES THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY**
- 8. THE RCMP ARE NOT EXPECTED TO ENFORCE THE DEVELOPMENT PERMIT, THE INDUSTRIAL HAUL AGREEMENTS OR IMPOSE ANY OF THE APPLICABLE ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES**
- 9. THE RCMP WILL ENFORCE THE TRAFFIC SAFETY ACT, AND OTHER LEGISLATION AS PER THEIR DIRECTIVES**
- 10. COPIES OF TICKETS TO BE SUPPLIED TO ENFORCEMENT SERVICES (THE INDUSTRIAL HAUL AGREEMENTS HAVE ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES ASSOCIATED TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS)**
- 11. THE RCMP WILL DIRECT THE PUBLIC TO CONTACT PARKLAND COUNTY AT (780) 968-8400 REGARDING GRAVEL TRUCK COMPLAINTS**

12. THE RCMP WILL SUPPLY PARKLAND COUNTY WITH A MONTHLY REPORT ON ACTIVITIES SPECIFIC TO THE ENHANCED GRAVEL ENFORCEMENT INITIATIVE BY THE 15<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF THE NEXT MONTH
13. THE RCMP WILL NOTIFY PARKLAND COUNTY WHEN A SCHEDULED SHIFT CANNOT BE COMPLETED (I.E. SICKNESS)

**PARKLAND COUNTY ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL:**

1. PARKLAND COUNTY ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL SUPPLY TO THE RCMP BOOKLETS CONTAINING COUNTY MAPS WITH THE LOCATIONS OF THE GRAVEL PITS, HAUL ROUTES, AND ALL APPLICABLE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE RCMP
2. THE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES OPERATIONS SUPERVISOR WILL LIAISE WITH THE RCMP ON A REGULAR BASIS TO IDENTIFY THE AREA(S) FOR GRAVEL FOCUSED ENFORCEMENT
3. THE OPERATIONS SUPERVISOR FOR ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL IDENTIFY THE DAYS OF THE WEEK AND TIMES OF THE DAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS ENHANCED AGREEMENT
4. ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL PROVIDE THESE TIMES ONE MONTH IN ADVANCE
5. ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL COLLECT THE DATA FROM THE RCMP THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY AFTER A SCHEDULED PATROL
6. ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL ENFORCE THE ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES CONTAINED IN THE INDUSTRIAL HAUL AGREEMENT
7. ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL LIAISE WITH COUNTY INTERNAL PARTNERS SUCH AS PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT DEPT, PUBLIC WORKS, ETC
8. ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WILL SUPPLY THE RCMP WITH A MONTHLY REPORT BY THE 15<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF THE NEXT MONTH.

**July 2013:**

- 10<sup>th</sup> – Times of focus – 0700 – 1000 hours and 1400 – 1800 hours
- 11<sup>th</sup> – Times of focus – 0700 – 1000 hours and 1400 – 1800 hours
- 20<sup>th</sup> – Times of focus – 0700 – 1000 hours and 1400 – 1800 hours and
- 27<sup>th</sup> – Times of focus – 0700 – 1000 hours and 1400 – 1800 hours.

**August 2013:**

- 17<sup>th</sup> – Times of focus – 0600 – 1100 hours and 1400 – 1900 hours and
- 24<sup>th</sup> – Times of focus – 0600 – 1100 hours and 1400 – 1900 hours.
