About \$295 million was paid out on crop insurance claims for the 2013 crop year across Alberta. The lion's share of payouts last year – roughly \$219 million – was triggered under the Hail Endorsement (HE) rider, an option 90 per cent of producers choose because hail is such a major weather risk in Alberta.
