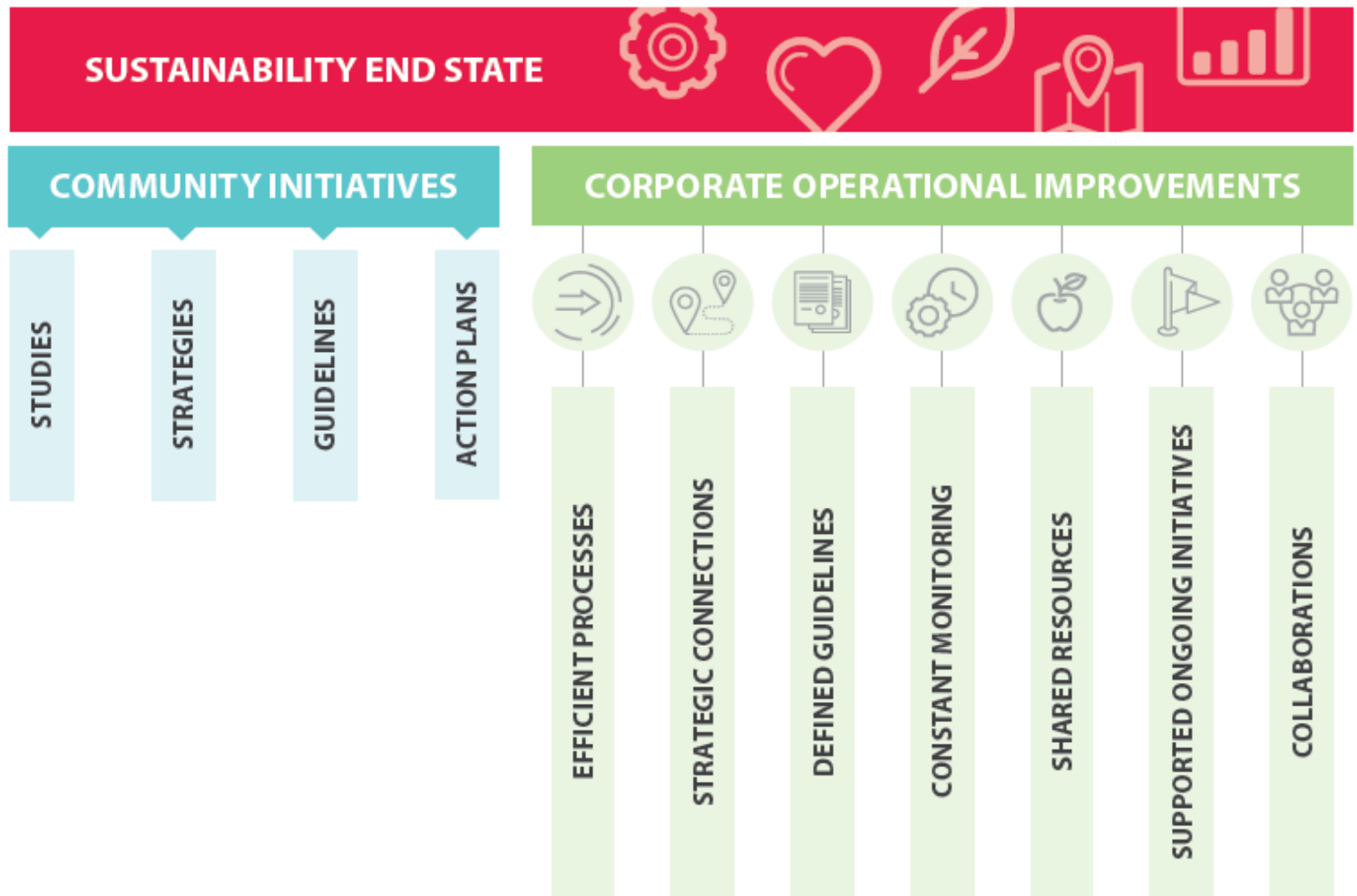

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

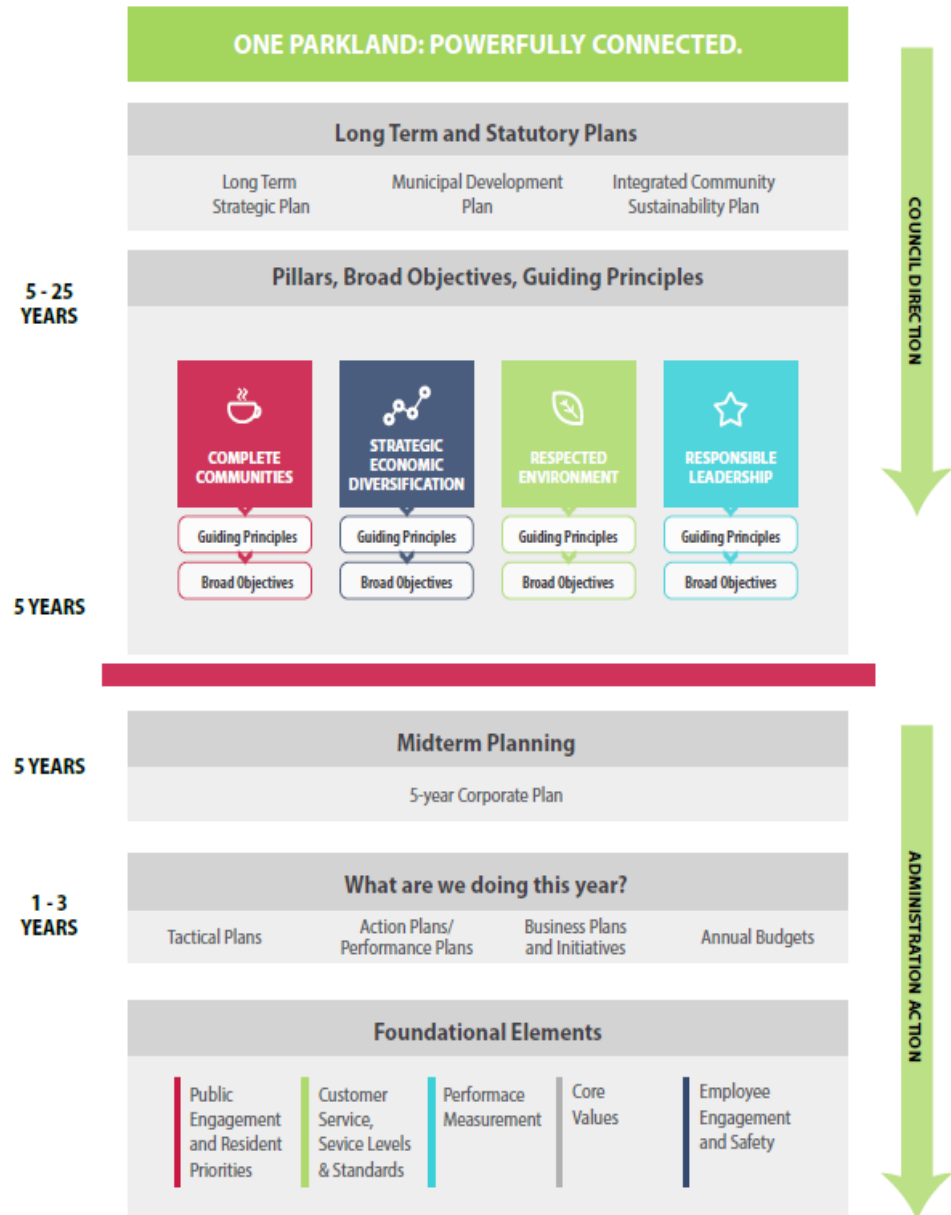
Address opportunities and challenges and divided into two categories:

- 3 outcomes for each element:
 - Clear understanding (current status & potential road blocks)
 - Simple communication
 - Effective & efficient implementation

- Progress towards achieving pillar definitions of sustainability

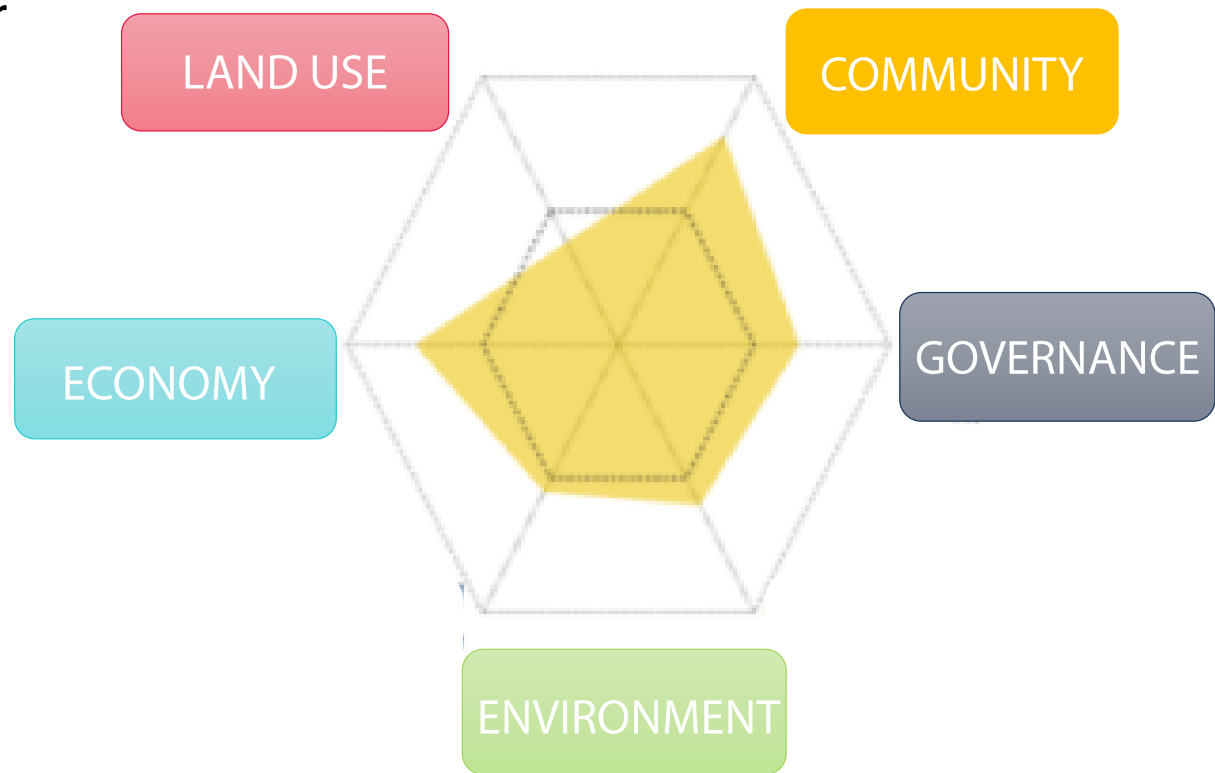

MONITORING GOALS

- Develop key performance indicators (KPIs) to monitor our achievement of objectives
- Easy to track, accessible information
- Organized by pillar
- Show integration between pillars
- Measure maintenance of comprehensive wealth
- Targets for each KPI



SEMI-ANNUAL REPORTS

- Efficiency- Coordinated with Strategic Planning updates
- Identify project status, risks to completion, next steps
- Organized by pillar

 Full Progress	<i>Full Progress – Work on the project is underway</i>
 Slow Progress	<i>Slow Progress – Work on the project is scheduled to begin at the end of 2018 or into 2019.</i>
 No Progress	<i>No Progress – Project is scheduled for late 2019 and beyond.</i>
 Unkown	<i>Progress Unknown – Planning and Development Services is not the lead on the project. Project status is to be communicated by the Project Lead Department.</i>

ANNUAL REPORTING

- 5 pillars of sustainability requires success & achievements in each area
- Objectives:
 - What we want to achieve
- Strategies:
 - How we will achieve it
- Actions:
 - What we will implement & track
- KPIs:
 - How we track & report

ONGOING STAKEHOLDER ROLES

ADMINISTRATION

Manages action implementation, processes monitoring data and presents to public, Council and Council Committees

COUNCIL COMMITTEES

Review progress and make recommendations for additional or adjusted actions

COUNCIL

Sets priorities and makes ultimate decisions regarding recommendations

COMMUNITY

Identifies priorities, follows implementation, partners on and leads certain actions, and provides feedback
