BACKGROUND

- No Joint Use Agreement currently in place
- MGA now requires one deadline is June 2025
- Uses of schools and municipal facilities have occurred
- Demand has been low



PURPOSE OF JOINT USE AGREEMENT

- Shared Access
- Funding of shared facilities and services
- Planning and acquisition for new or expanded school sites

County Facilities

- Entwistle Community Recreation
 Centre
- Wabamun Community Hall

- Meridian Sports Park
- Coal Diamond Sports Park



CURRENT METHOD OF USE/BOOKING/MANAGEMENT

- Schools via Principals
- County Facilities via Community services
- Charges/Fees based on needs for specialized staff or additional cleaning required to support the use
- Parkland School Division (PSD) maintains their buildings and fields
- Parkland County maintains their buildings and fields



NEW METHOD OF USE/BOOKING/MANAGEMENT

- Schools via PSD Facilities Department
- County remains the same via Community Services
- Charges/Fees remain the same
- Management of buildings/fields remains the same no change



ADDITIONAL POINTS OF NOTE

- Council and PSD Board will meet at least ever three years.
- Operating Committee made up of the CAO and Superintendent or their designates will meet annually
- Planning for any future school sites will be communicated by PSD to Parkland County to begin those discussions
- Disposal of School sites
