BYLAW 2016-25

BEING A BYLAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY TO
AMEND DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS BYLAW NO. 11-2011

WHEREAS the Council of Parkland County has passed a Bylaw pursuant to Section 7 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c.M-26, as amended, known as the Discharge of Firearms Bylaw for the purpose of restricting the discharge of specific guns or firearms or specific uses in any specified part or parts of Parkland County;

WHEREAS Council of Parkland County deems it necessary and appropriate to amend Bylaw No. 11-2011 to restrict the discharge of firearms on lands districted as a form of Country Residential;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Parkland County, duly assembled and under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, hereby enacts the following:

BYLAW 11-2011 AMENDMENTS

1. That Bylaw No. 11-2011 being the Discharge of Firearms Bylaw is amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 3.1(c) shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - (c) All multi-parcel residential subdivisions approved by Parkland County or zoned Country Residential, Country Residential Restricted, Cluster (Conservation) Country Residential or Country Residential Estate pursuant to the Land Use Bylaw and amendments thereto.
 - (2) Section 4.2 shall be deleted in its entirety.
 - (3) Section 4.3 shall be renumbered as Section 4.2.
 - (4) Section 4.5 shall be renumbered as Section 4.3.
 - (5) Section 4.6 shall be renumbered as Section 4.4.
 - (6) Adding a new Section 4.5 to read:
 - 4.5 A person, with the consent of the property owner, hunting wildlife on private property in accordance with the *Wildlife Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c.W-10 or in exercise of a Treaty or Aboriginal right to harvest.

ENACTMENT/TRANSITION

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of third reading and signing thereof.
