Municipal Impacts of CFTA and CETA

In April, the details of the <u>Canadian Free Trade Agreement</u> (CFTA) were released. The CFTA is a Canada-wide trade agreement between provinces that has replaced the current Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT). The CFTA broadens the scope of industries that are covered by inter-provincial trade rules and is intended to align with international trade agreements. At its core, the CFTA prohibits discriminating among goods, services, workers and investments based on their province or territory of origin.
