

**RATES AND CHARGES FOR WASTEWATER SERVICES DISCHARGING
INTO
THE HAMLET OF ENTWISTLE WASTEWATER SYSTEM**

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS
OF BY-LAW 1-2003
RATES EFFECTIVE: January 1, 2013

1. Applies to properties with metered water consumption:
 - a) Single Family Residential Unit
 - i. Fixed Service Charge - \$20.00 per month
 - ii. Usage charge of \$0.79 per cubic metre based on metered water consumption
 - b) Commercial Business
 - i. Fixed Service Charge - \$20.00 per month
 - ii. Usage charge of \$0.79 per cubic metre based on metered water consumption
2. A Fixed Service Charge of \$20.00 per month in addition to the charges outlined below shall apply to properties without metered water consumption:

a) Single Family Residential (based on 20 m3/month)	\$15.80 per month

b) Community Center (based on 20 m3/month)	\$15.80 per month
Fixed Service Charge	\$20.00 per month
c) Small Community Business (based on 25 m3/month)	\$19.75 per month

- a) A non- refundable one time authorization charge of \$100.00 for each tank truck unit accepted and approved for wastewater discharge into a Designated Facility in the Hamlet of Entwistle. Charge includes the issue of a key and/or an access card to a Designated Facility.
 - b) A charge of \$10.00 for each replacement of a lost or damaged key or access card.
 - c) A charge of \$100.00 for re-authorization of a de-authorized access card.

**RATES AND CHARGES FOR WASTEWATER SERVICES DISCHARGING
INTO
THE PARKLAND REGIONAL TRUNK SEWER LINE**

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS
OF BY-LAW 1-2003
RATES EFFECTIVE: January 1, 2013

1. The rate per cubic metre as shown below, for normal sanitary sewage (wastewater which meets the requirements of Part V of By-law No. 1-2003)
 - a) Non Metered Residential: \$20.00 per month fixed service charge plus a usage charge of \$1.13 per cubic metre for properties serviced by a piped connection to an available adjacent municipal sewerage system discharging into the Parkland Regional Trunk Sewer Line. Based on a usage of 20 cubic metres per month (municipal sewerage infrastructure operated and maintained by the County).
 - b) Commission Customers: \$1.13 per cubic metre for properties serviced by a piped connection to an available adjacent private sewerage system discharging into the Parkland Regional Trunk Sewer Line or by an approved piped connection directly to the Parkland Regional Trunk Sewer Line (no municipal sewerage infrastructure to be operated and maintained by the County).
 - c) Wastewater hauled to and discharged into a Designated Facility in the County that connects to the Alberta Capital Region Wastewater Commission (ACRWC) transmission and treatment system:
 - i. Effective January 1, 2013 - \$6.18 per cubic meter
 - d) Acheson Sewerage System - \$20.00 per month fixed service charge plus a usage charge of \$1.13 per cubic metre based on metered water consumption.
 - e) Big Lake Sewerage System - \$20.00 per month fixed service charge plus a usage charge of \$1.13 per cubic metre based on metered water consumption.
 - f) Parkland Village – a usage charge as specified in (b) above based on metered water consumption.
 - g) Overstrength and Additional Overstrength Surcharges may be assessed to a wastewater generator or wastewater hauler for any wastewater that exceeds the Concentration Limits as outlined in the Bylaw of Parkland County for the Prevention, Restriction, Regulation and Control of the Discharge of Wastewater into Wastewater Collection, Treatment and Disposal Systems within Parkland County.
2. The following charges to approved sewage haulers for the right of access to and use of transfer stations and sewerage systems in the County;
 - a) A non- refundable one time authorization charge of \$100.00 for each tank truck unit accepted and approved for wastewater discharge into transfer stations in the County. Charge includes the issue of a key and/or an access card to a Designated Facility.
 - b) A charge of \$10.00 for each replacement of a lost or damaged key or access card.
 - c) A charge of \$100.00 for re-authorization of a de-authorized access card.

 - c) A charge of \$100.00 for re-authorization of a de-authorized access card.
