

June 29th, 2014 Board Meeting Highlights

- Strategic Debt Discussion – Staff provided some background and an overview of the current limitations and assumptions and the Board participated in an in-depth exercise and discussion regarding debt strategies to allow the ACRWC to maintain a sustainable financial position. Staff will use the results from this discussion to prepare strategies for presentation and discussion at the July Board meeting.

- The Official Opening of the new St. Albert Pump Station took place on June 18th with event speakers Darrell Hollands, ACRWC Chair, Cathy Heron representing the City of St. Albert, Karen Shaw representing Sturgeon County, and Gil Carleton, Design and Construction Manager from the ACRWC. Tours were offered to the media and those in attendance. This new \$19 million wastewater pump station is one of five pump stations along the ACRWC wastewater transmission system and was built to address previous system degradation and to support the increasing demand of St. Albert's growing population.
