Province Launches Campaign to Raise Awareness for Voter I.D. Requirements

changes to the Local Authorities Election Act in 2012 require all electors to provide verification of their name and address in order to vote in municipal elections. To ensure that all voters are aware of the new requirement for the 2013 general elections, the Government of Alberta will be sponsoring advertisements in local and regional newspapers across Alberta in the coming weeks, and a number of social media initiatives will also be carried out. The awareness campaign will feature a stylized logo “Right ID – Right To Vote”, and will direct readers to visit the Government of Alberta home page and to check with their municipality for more information.
