



- 1. Designed to be flexible and adaptable
- 2. Routine minor updates expected
- 3. Ongoing monitoring during implementation
- 4. Updates required by MGA



## **Amendment 1**

# Conceptual Scheme Definition

#### **Conceptual Scheme**

A non-statutory planning document that is approved by Council resolution without a Public Hearing. It may contain a range of planning information at the County's discretion. It is typically used to: (a) add new information or detail to an area within an existing ASP, or (b) replace the function of an ASP. A Conceptual Scheme typically addresses smaller areas compared to an ASP.

A non-statutory planning document that is approved by Council resolution without a Public Hearing (Industrial Conceptual Schemes) or by the Director of Planning and Development Services (Rural Conceptual Schemes). It may contain a range of planning information at the County's discretion.

# Master Site Development Plan Definition

Master Site
Development Plan

A design proposal for how a large property will look when development and construction is complete, or how a resource/aggregate extraction business will operate. <- these two conditions seem like very different things.

Means a non-statutory document providing a comprehensive plan for a large-scale Major Development that provides a framework for future Development, offsite impacts, and provisions for public infrastructure.

Administration finds Bylaw 2025-16 to be in alignment with Council's Strategic Plan, and presents the following options for Councils consideration:


- 1. If Council desires to receive further information, Council may adjourn the Public Hearing to continue to receive additional information accordingly.

OR

b) That Bylaw 2024-22 be presented for first, second and third at a later date or a date directed by Council.


