

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

Topic: Yellowhead County Capital Cost Share Request

Introduction:

Parks, Recreation and Culture is presenting a recommendation with regards to the Recreation Capital Cost Share requests that we have received from one of our municipal partners, Yellowhead County. These activities are being undertaken to turn an under-utilized and unused used space into a space that will be used to address current recreation needs of the Entwistle/Evansburg region.

Background Information:

As part of the Recreation Cost Share Agreements we have with our municipal partners, Council may, at their discretion, provide funding support for capital repairs or upgrades at the facilities outlined in each of the agreements.

Administration has received a request from Yellowhead County. As part of their ongoing renovation plans for the former riding arena at the Evansburg Arena, this year will see the completion of a number of projects to complete this multipurpose space, turning an under-utilized and unused used space into a space that will be used to address current recreation needs of residents in the region.
